

THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
MARIE REAY SCHOLARSHIP IN ANTHROPOLOGY

AWARD CONDITIONS

1. This award is to be named in honour of Dr Marie Reay, one of the distinguished members of the Department of Anthropology, Research School of Pacific and Asian Studies at the Australian National University over 1959-1987.
2. The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students in the Department of Anthropology with the financial burdens of conducting ethnographic fieldwork during their programme of postgraduate research for a Doctor of Philosophy degree at the Research School of Pacific and Asian Studies.
3. The value of this scholarship in any one year will be \$500.
4. The scholarship shall be awarded each year to the student who, enrolled in the Anthropology Department leading to the award of the Doctor of Philosophy degree in Anthropology offered by the Research School of Pacific and Asian Studies, has completed an application for funding support that is judged by the Selection Committee to be the most likely to enhance the quality of the applicant's field research.
5. The Selection Committee shall be determined, from time to time, by the Head of the Department of Anthropology, RSPAS. The Selection Committee will make a recommendation on the scholarship to the Director, RSPAS once each year, normally in September.
6. The scholarship application will consist of a maximum one-page single-spaced request and justification for a field research expense that cannot be covered by the Department of Anthropology's normal fieldwork allocation (up to \$8500 per student in 2007). The scholarship application should be submitted to the Selection Committee no later than 1 September each academic year attached to the fieldwork budget.
6. The Selection Committee will may take into account the information contained in the scholarship application and gathered during the annual review of student progress.
7. The scholarship may be shared.
8. The School reserves the right not to award the scholarship in a given year.
