- What sorts of things do you do in your family?
- Are there advantages/disadvantages to living in a cross-cultural family?
- What language do you speak at home?
- Can you tell me about your friends
- What sorts of things do you do with your friends?
- Are you involved in the Filipino/Indonesian community? Do you attend fiestas, get-togethers, cultural/youth activities, community school?
- Do you enjoy these activities?
- Are there any children from a similar background to you in your school/ other activities?
- Do you know any other Filipinos/Indonesians?
- Have you been to the Philippines/Indonesia?
- What is special for you about going to the Philippines/Indonesia?
- What do you know about the Philippines/Indonesia?
- Do you talk about the Philippines/Indonesia with your mum/dad?

- Have you ever experienced racism in Australia?
- What sorts of stories and news reports do you read/see in newspapers, film etc about women and men from the Philippines/Indonesia, and families from a similar background to your family?
- Can you tell me how you feel about these sorts of stories or news reports?
- What sorts of things, if anything, do you do in response to these stories/reports?
- Do you use the internet, eg email, chat, websites, to keep in touch with family members and friends?
