**PMB 1099**     **LUXTON, Rev. Clarence T J:** diaries, correspondence and related papers, 1945-47. (Available for reference.)

Rev. Clarence T. J. Luxton: born, 19 June 1907; married, 21 June 1938 (Mavis - 9 children); died, 19 Nov 1979.

The NZ Methodist Overseas Mission sent Rev Luxton and his wife, Mavis, to Buka in 1939 and they were evacuated in the same year. They returned to the Solomon Islands in April 1945 and were sent to Bilua Vella Lavella, then Torokina, in Bougainville. Their daughter, Moyra, died there in April 1946. Rev. Luxton supervised construction of a new church in Buka in 1947. Sickness necessitated withdrawal from the Mission in 1949.
